- 1. Minutes from the January general meeting were read aloud and approved by the members.
- 2. Bruce Richman, Treasurer, stated that the RCA's fund is \$20,708.92 and that 23 members have paid for the year 2014.
- 3. Steve Horton continues to knock of the doors of local businesses on behalf of RCA. He recommended to the membership, that if you have a contact person of a company within RCA to please forward that information and he will pay them a visit.
- 4. Larry Dooling reported on the groundbreaking ceremony of the Port Richmond trail that occurred last 03/05/14. Plans are to take the trail up to Orthodox Street in Bridesburg but there is a hurdle because a bridge has to be built over the Frankford Creek to do so. The Buckley Company is the contractor.
- 5. Tioga Marine terminal recently announced a new expansion contract.

- 6. The RCA Breakfast Event will occur on May 2, 2014 at the Columbia Club on Almond St. Many politicians are expected to attend including some gubernatorial candidates.
- 7. Georg Groves announced the news that John McDonald from Impact Services is retiring in July.
- 8. George also discuss the importance that RCA should get involved with the application of Port Richmond being declared an Enterprise Zone. The zone will extend 1 mile westward from the Delaware river.
- 9. I-95 is expanding eastward 80 feet instead of the originally planned 40 feet. This will impact many businesses along the I-95 corridor in our area. Aqueducts will also need to be dug and installed in most streets to handle the storm water flow from the highway. This will probably cause a huge problem with traffic flow along our streets (Tioga, Venango, etc...).
- 10. CSX railroad wants to put a spur behind the Philadelphia Regional Port Authority (PRPA) to hold 20 cars containing solvent.
- 11. The Spring Cleanup will be held on April 5, 2014. Meeting at 9 am outside of Bonk's Bar & Grill.
- 12. L&I will be sending a letter to Camden Iron to cease and desist.
- 13. George Groves mentioned that the waiting line to speak with L&I at the Municipal Services Building is about 4 hours long. The city recently announced that every license will require a clearance from the city's tax revenue department. It is a good idea to obtain a timestamp on all documents and checks.
- 14. Tariq Darvez announced the ribbon-cutting ceremony for the new TD Bank at (near Wal-Mart) will occur on March 22, 2014. All are invited to the ceremony will will begin arounf 8:30 am.
